# **Job Description for Swim Coaches**

# Position: Full-Time and Part-Time Swim Coaches

### **Job Overview**

We are seeking dedicated and passionate Swim Coaches to join our team. The ideal candidates will be responsible for training swimmers of various skill levels, from beginners to advanced competitors. Coaches will promote a positive and motivating environment while ensuring the safety and well-being of all participants. This role requires commitment, punctuality, and a strong work ethic, as well as the ability to adapt coaching styles to meet the diverse needs of swimmers.

## Responsibilities

- **Conduct Swim Practices**: Lead daily swim practices five days a week, focusing on skill development, technique improvement, and endurance training. Utilize drills and exercises that cater to different skill levels.
- **Support at Swim Meets**: Attend all swim meets, providing emotional and tactical support to athletes. Prepare swimmers for competition by discussing strategies and setting performance goals.
- **Professionalism**: Arrive on time for all scheduled practices and meets, ensuring a professional atmosphere that reflects the values of the organization.
- **Enforce Policies**: Implement and enforce a no-technology policy on the pool deck to maintain focus and engagement during practices and meets. Educate athletes on the importance of this policy for their development.
- **Effective Communication**: Communicate effectively with athletes, parents, and other coaches
- **Training Plans Development**: Develop and implement individualized training plans tailored to each swimmer's needs, considering their goals, strengths, and areas for improvement.
- **Monitor Progress**: Regularly assess swimmer progress through time trials, skill assessments, and feedback sessions. Provide constructive feedback to help athletes reach their potential.
- **Team Culture**: Foster a positive team culture that encourages teamwork, sportsmanship, and inclusivity. Organize team-building activities and encourage peer support among athletes.

Classic and City weeks will also add to the hours of the week Evening and weekend availability are mandatory based on meets including mandatory attendance at Classic and City.
- **Part-Time Hours** Coaches are expected to work approx 15 hours per week (2.5 hrs x 5 days; 5 hours x 1 meet a week), mandatory attendance at Classic and City.
- **Meet Attendance for** *Full-Time*: Must be available for all swim meets, including Saturdays. Classic and City Meets are Mandatory. Coaches are expected to travel to meets as necessary.
- **Meet Attendance for** *Part-Time*: Must be available for one swim swim meet a week which may include the Saturday meets. Classic and City Meets are mandatory. Coaches are expected to travel to meets as necessary.
- **Special Event Attendance for** *Full-Time*: Required to be at New Swimmer Testing Day, Picture Day, and one of the Pasta Parties (alternating with the other full-time coaches to make sure there is enough coverage by the coaches. The End of Year Party is also a mandatory event.
- **Special Event Attendance for** *Part-Time*: New Swimmer Testing Day, Picture Day, Pasta Parties, and The End of Year Party are all optional.
- **Technology Policy**: Adherence to the no-technology policy on deck is mandatory to promote safety, focus, and engagement during practices.

# **Employment Contract for Swim Coaches**

# **Contract Agreement**

- 5. **Compensation**: Employee will receive compensation as agreed upon in a separate document. Compensation will be reviewed annually based on performance and team budget.

### **Termination**

Either party may terminate this Contract with a written notice of two weeks. Grounds for immediate termination include but are not limited to gross misconduct, violation of safety protocols, or failure to adhere to the no-technology policy.
